

The online portal for the Spring 2023 round of funding will open on Monday, February 27.

The deadline for all applications is 11:59 PM Friday, May 5.

But first! Learn about key changes we are making. As a result of recommendations from our Imagining Equitable Futures work, we are modifying our application process. These changes will help us to move now towards more equitable funding. We're excited to embrace this vital work, and we appreciate your willingness to comply with new requirements.

First, we are focusing on "Where Arts Starts"

We encourage applications from artists and from organizations that want to experiment, to explore new creation processes—including disciplines other than their own—or to build on new work. For more details and definitions, please review the revised 2023 guidelines carefully. You can find those here.

Second, watch for eligibility criteria!

Individuals: when you apply, you will be asked to identify <u>either</u> as an emerging or established artist;. See criteria spelled out <u>here</u>.

- Emerging Artists can apply for up to \$10,000
- Established Artists can apply for up to \$7,500

Organizations, groups & ad hoc collectives: when you apply, you will be asked to identify either as emerging <u>or</u> established. See criteria spelled out <u>here</u>.

- Emerging Organizations can apply for up to \$10,000
- Established Organizations can apply for up to \$7,500

Third, now Peer Reviewers (formerly Artists-at-Large) will assess all applications.

In the past, Board members were joined by Artists-at-Large to adjudicate the grants. This will no longer be the case. Instead, an advisory group comprised of seasoned local artists and arts administrators will become RWAF Peer Reviewers, and will be paid to do this work. Why change, why now? Changes you see here reflect an extensive process that included a consultant, RWAF board members, and a group of locally based racialized artists. The latest phase of this work has resulted in a detailed report, Moving Recommendations Forward. As the report points out, change takes time and thoughtful planning. RWAF is starting with the Spring 2023 round of funding.
